The natural-looking colling-to-floor wate pond and shower are of fisses stone and ' designed and installed by Tommy Basco.

If you haven't guessed by now, Lindi is kn acound the valley as the bird lady and the Bi South Palm Desert home on Joshua Tree is r secondary to the grounds and aviaries, inte and exteriors designed with no soft surfaces.

"God put birds here to reseed so they rend to things apart and move them; it's called seed sow," explains Lindi. "Hard surfaces keep house intact."

Five dogs punctuate the exotic and ong sounds of a sizable population of mac flamingos, parrors, and toucars.

"When I was young, people thought I was m says Lindi. "Now I'm old enough to just eccentric."

Either way, she finds that the master bath is center of calm. And it's all about that gently n ing water.
